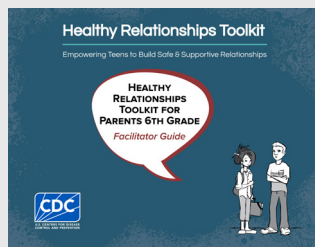
## HEALTHY RELATIONSHIPS TOOLKIT PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Healthy Relationships Toolkit (HeaRT) promotes healthy relationship behaviors to prevent violence before it starts. The model focuses on 11- to 14-year-olds to prevent dating violence, sexual violence, bullying, and other risk behaviors in middle school and across the lifespan. It includes multiple prevention components that focus on individuals, peers, families, schools, and neighborhoods. These components work together to reinforce and promote respectful, nonviolent relationships. Below are the how-to guides, program materials, and links you will need to deliver the HeaRT program in your community.

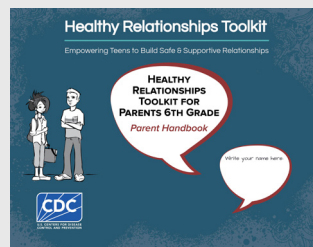
## PARENT PROGRAM MATERIALS

HeaRT includes three parent programs that teach skills and strategies to help parents protect their middle school students from teen dating violence. These programs were developed for parents of youth in grades 6, 7, and 8 as part of the HeaRT model. However, the tools and ideas in these programs will likely be helpful for parents with children of all ages.

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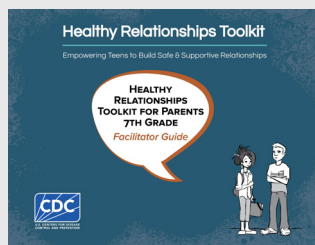

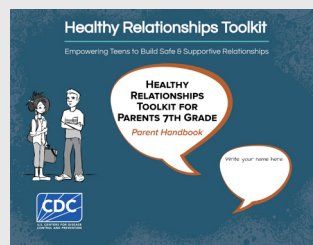

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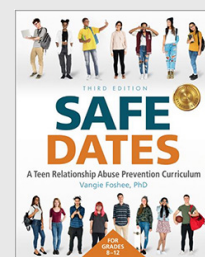
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### 8th Grade

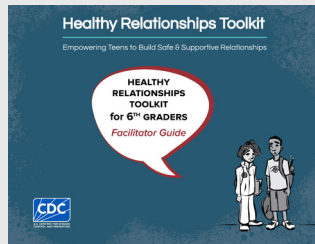
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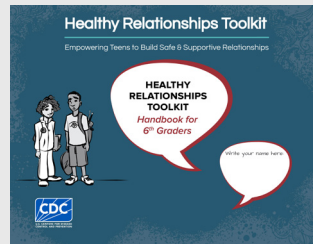
## YOUTH PROGRAM MATERIALS

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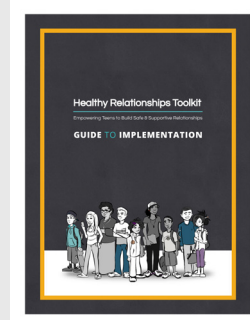
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## GUIDE-TO MATERIALS

### Guide to Implementation

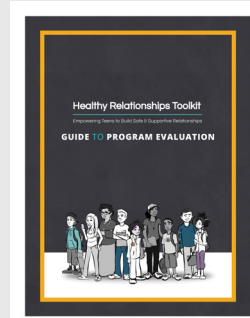
